Temple Beth Emeth keeps dues and tuition low by operating on a very tight budget. We rely heavily on the members of our congregation to keep our temple running. All member families are asked to:

- “Adopt a Shabbat” – host one Oneg per year (refreshments following Friday night service) and participate in honors during the service (light candles, etc.)
- Volunteer for a committee or project
- Assist with one event each year: holiday planning, youth activities or education event
- Participate in weekly services and holiday celebrations
- Attend community events including bar/bat mitzvahs and shiva minyans
